

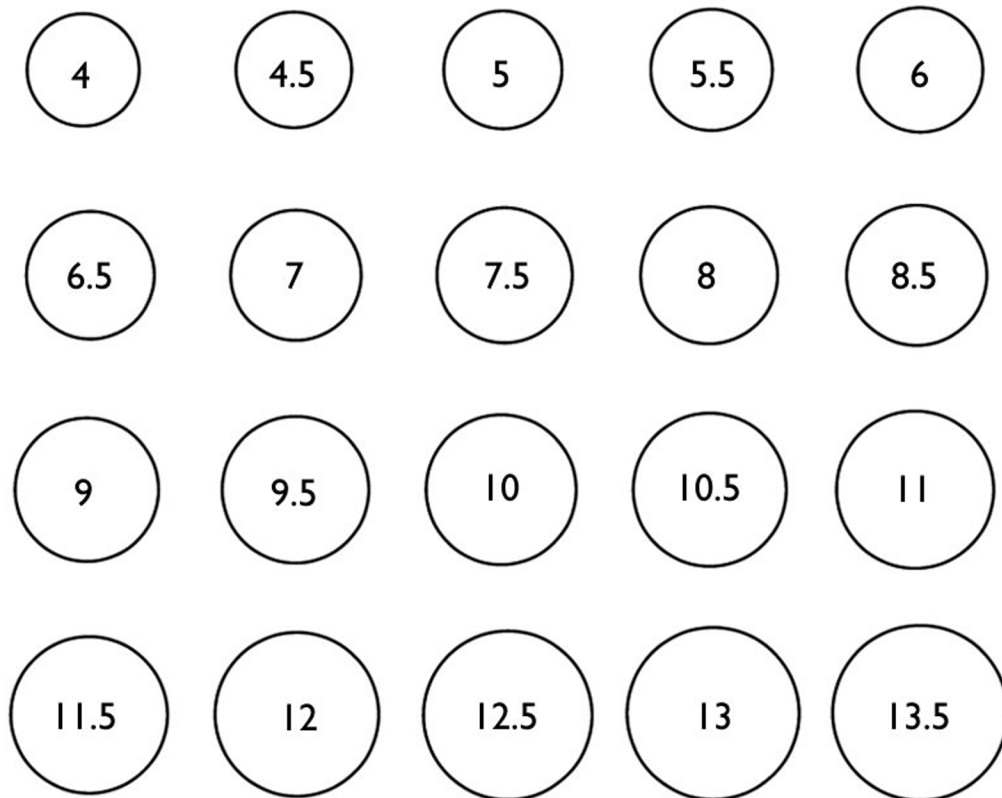


RING SIZING

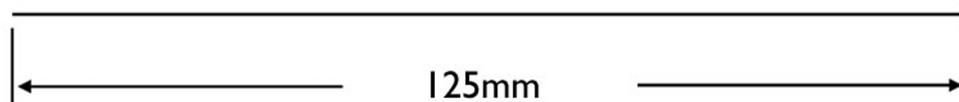
For the most accurate sizing, it's always best to see a professional but in a pinch here are two methods to try at home

METHOD 1

Place a ring you already own over a circle to find its size. The ring should cover the circle so that the black circle touches the **inside** of the ring.



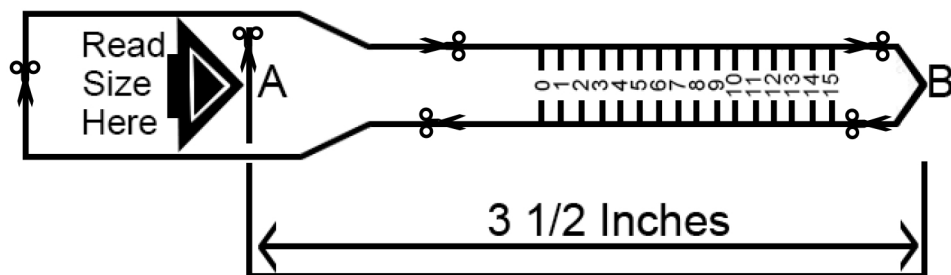
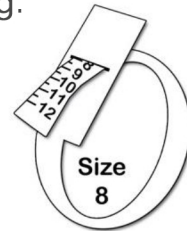
Print this page at 100% and make sure the line below is 125 mm.



METHOD 2

- 1) Print this page at 100%. Make sure the line below is 3.5 inches (89 cm)
- 2) Cut around the sizer.
- 3) Cut a small slit on the dotted (A) line. Be careful not to cut all the way.
- 4) Slip the pointed tab (B) through the slit and slide onto your finger.
- 5) Pull the tab until it fits your finger and read size.
